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What is Witchcraft ?

Modern-day witchcraft is known as a ritual and practice that incorporates a belief in magic and that is associated especially with neo-pagan traditions and religions (such as Wicca) use of sorcery, magic, or supernatural powers to inflict harm or misfortune on people or animals. The modern-day English word witchcraft has three principal connotations: the practice of magic or sorcery worldwide; the beliefs associated with the Western witch hunts of the 14th to the 18th century; and varieties of the modern movement called Wicca, frequently mispronounced "wikka."

The word "witch" derives from the Old English words "wicca" and "wicce" (masculine and feminine forms, respectively). This later became "wicche", in Middle English, which meant the same thing as "wicca" and "wicce", but didn't distinguish between the genders, being used to refer to both men and women. Yet, much further back in ancient time, it was never mention as feminine alone. However, over time, using "wicche" to refer to men became less and less common, being replaced by synonyms such as "wizard", "warlock", and/or "sorcerer". By the 16th century, the spelling had changed over time from "wicche" to "witch" and, by this time, the word was almost exclusively used to refer to women, as it still is today.

However, in the Wiccan religion, it is now once again somewhat confusing and common to use "witch" to refer to both men and women. In this case, though, they use witch to simply refer to "an adherent of Wicca". The origin of the words "wicca" and "wicce" isn't entirely known, but it is thought the words themselves originally meant "*wise one*", with the earliest references to these words in Old English always seeming to be associated with <u>fortune-telling</u> and "teaching", based on that foreknowledge. So the question is, is this a good thing to have a witch among us? Because we have heard in historical stories that there are not just bad witches out there but some good witches?

Because of this Witchcraft is traditionally the exercise or invocation of alleged supernatural powers to control people or events, practices typically involving sorcery or magic. Although defined differently in disparate historical and cultural contexts, witchcraft has often been seen, especially in the West, as the work of crones who meet secretly at night, indulge in cannibalism and orgiastic rites with the Devil, or Satan, and perform black magic. This is why most people view this as bad witches.

Witchcraft thus defined exists more in the imagination of contemporaries than in any objective reality. Yet this stereotype has a long history and has constituted for many cultures a viable explanation of evil in the world. The intensity of these beliefs is best represented by the European witch hunts of the 14th to 18th century, but witchcraft and its associated ideas are never far from the surface of popular consciousness and—sustained by folk tales—find explicit focus from time to time in popular television and films and fiction. But, this whole thing about witches and their witchcraft work only gives us about 75%, while the remainder of 25% is hidden from us knowing more about it. Well, it originally came from the Latin word "scientia" which meant "knowledge", a knowing, expertness, or experience. By the late 14th century, science meant, in English, a collective knowledge. But it has consistently carried the meaning of being a socially embedded activity: people seeking, systematizing, and sharing knowledge. So now we know where this word "science" has come from, KNOWLEDGE. Before there were doctors and/or scientists, there were people who were a philosopher, a philosopher who did a lot of observatory research. A person who offers views or theories on profound questions in ethics, metaphysics, logic, and other related fields. A person who is deeply versed in philosophy. They also perform like what scientists do. Because again, they are observant ones who research and collect knowledge.

Speaking of "OBSERVANT", one of the most important words that most people no longer are aware of is how this word has been replaced with the understanding word of "RELIGION". • Astrology: Astrology is the study of the movements and positions of celestial bodies and their influence on human affairs and natural events. Many witches were adept astrologers, as they knew how to observe, calculate, and interpret the stars and planets for divination, prediction, or guidance. Some witches also used astrological symbols and tools, such as charts, tables, calendars, or instruments, in their laboratories. Some famous astrological witches include Nostradamus, Mother Shipton, and Catherine de Medici.

• Necromancy: Necromancy is the practice of communicating with or raising the dead for various purposes. Many witches were involved in necromancy, as it offered them a way to access hidden knowledge, summon spirits or demons, or control zombies or skeletons.
