

# **The Promised New World: Trusting Only יהוה's Words**

*יהוה will return, not Jesus*

The book of Malachi is the last reminder about the New Covenant יהוה made a promised with the Israelite. He did mentioned about the day HE will return for the judgment day, and there will be a New Heaven and New Earth. This last reminder mentioned in chapters 3 and/or 4.

***"For behold, the day is coming –it will burn like a furnace– when all the proud and every evildoer will become stubble. The day that is coming will set them ablaze" –says יהוה – "leaving them neither root nor branch. But for you who revere My Name, the sun of righteousness will rise, with healing in its wings. Then you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall. You will trample on the wicked, for they will be ashes under the soles of your feet in which that day I will be making," says יהוה, your Creator Almighty ONE" - Malachi 3:19-21***

Next verse (v. 22) mentioned that יהוה will have Elijah return to earth before HIS coming of the great and terrible day? The death from their grave will rise and still be on earth. Because they will be walking on the sinner's ashes. From that passage verse, they did not go straight up to the heavens where יהוה's kingdom of heaven at all. Because also, יהוה is returning that day with HIS kingdom here on earth taking over the world. He will rule this world forever and ever. Isaiah 65:16-17 also mentioned that death will be awakened alive during this new heavens and new earth.

***"...one who swears an oath in the land shall swear by יהוה's trustworthiness, because the former troubles are forgotten, and they are hidden from my eyes. For look! I am about to create new heavens and a new earth, and the former things shall not be remembered, and they shall not come to mind."***

***"...everyone who is found written in the scroll. And many who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake – some to everlasting life, and others to shame and everlasting contempt." - Daniel 12:1-2***

During the renewing of the heavens and earth, the terrible past of suffering will never again ever happen again. So, we can see how and why this is completely different from what the New Testament Revelation book reveals us about the judgment day would be like. Nothing like there would be a day of rapture at all.

What we need to fully understand is what the prophecy foretold to us from the Old Testament books. We should never-mind about what Jesus said in the New Testament books. Otherwise, we would be misled and confused with both Testament books. Isaiah 11:11-16, clearly said that **אֲשֶׁר** will return to us once again. To regather the remnant of HIS people again, **the 2nd time. Please read the whole chapter 11 of Isaiah**, it will amaze you. Because that passage books explains everything clearly to us what will happen in the coming last day. Before the new world, a new kingdom where there will be no sins on earth. People will live in peace during this everlasting new kingdom. Just as how HE gathered all of HIS people out of Egypt slavery. That was the first time, the second time hadn't happen yet.

**“ אֲשֶׁר will again redeem—a second time with His hand—the remnant of His people who remain from Assyria, from Egypt, from Pathros, from Cush, Elam, Shinar, Hamath, and from the islands of the sea...**

**.....there will be a highway for the remnant of His people who remain, from Assyria, as there was for Israel in the day they came up out of the land of Egypt.”**

The remnants of HIS people from four corners of the earth are scattered. Since the day after the **Babylon Empire**, the **Meda-Peria Empire**, and the **Greek** and **Roman empire**, they all have been scattered. Since after Romans destroyed the Temple in Israel, **אֲשֶׁר** have been silent to us ever since. All this is true, it did happened.

Let's hold on about Isaiah chapter 11 because we're gonna need to read another book. A book of Daniel, a prophet who interprets King Nebuchadnezzar's mystery dream. Nebuchadnezzar's mystery dream was about this odd statue. An odd image of the statue he saw was an image of the head of fine gold, chest, and arms of silver, belly, and thighs of bronze, legs of iron, and feet and toes partly of

iron and partly of clay (verses 31-33). And then there was a great stone that was cut out without hands (verse 34) — it struck the image of these feet of iron and clay. This stone became a huge mountain that will fill the whole earth (verse 35).

## Nebuchadnezzar's Dream of the Statue



This dream was all about the prophecy timeline which will take place in the future. So far, this prophecy timeline has already been fulfilled mostly. Knowing the history of Babylon as head of gold, Meda-Peria as chest and arms of silver, Greek as belly and thighs of bronze, and **Rome as the legs of iron**. The feet of the ten toes that are a mixture of iron and clay are where we are at today's timeline. Because every nation around the world is not ruled by one single king as in the ancient Babylon or Rome days. This is why we see partly **iron** as a previous Roman custom ending up mixed with **clay** because of the mixed culture of nations (people). Since Roman

Empire dye out slowly because they couldn't handle the large amount of population that grew all over the world. Yet, their custom still carries on in some of the nation's today like America, Canada, Australia, and some other areas in European as well.

So, the remainder of this dream is the stone which is cut out without hands will strike the image of the feet of iron and clay. This stone which will become like a mountain is symbolized as 𐤀𐤃𐤃's kingdom. This stone is the other timeline that hadn't happened yet. **From this prophecy timeline, between the legs of iron (as Roman Empire timeline) and the stone which is**

**cut out without hands that will strike the ten toes' feet of iron and clay is where we are today.**

The mixture of iron and clay is the timeline we must recognize. We must accept Daniel's prophecy against the so-called John the Revelator book of the New Testament. If we focus only the Old Testament (or TANAKH), we will be much clearer to understand about this prophecy timeline according to Daniel. Yet, beginner still have to research on the history along with the Scripture books to be able to figure it out.



Now let us get back to Isaiah chapter 11, did we notice it mentioned about the Gulf of the Egyptian sea (v. 15)? It will dry up and there will be a change in the rivers in the east? In that scripture, it said that אֲרָם's people from the east will cross it. As far as we know today, did we notice what was going on with the Nile

River and the Euphrates River lately? Both are drying up slowly and it seems very likely this is the coming sign of אֲרָם. Soon, people who wear sandals from the East will be able to cross it. And somehow the remnant of אֲרָם's people from a faraway land in the west like America or Brazil and fairway east like Australia will also come to Israel.

***"Fear not, for I am with you; I will bring your offspring from the east, and from the west I will gather you. I will say to the north, Give up, and to the south, Do not withhold; bring my sons from afar and my daughters from the end of the earth" - Isaiah 43:5-6***

So we can see why the New Testament Revelation or any other book that speaks about the rapture day or how the good saint will rise first and their body will change into a spiritual glorify way. After the millennium (1K years) of peace on earth, the second resurrection, the wicked will rise afterward is just all untrue.

***"...believe that Jesus (or Yeshua) died and rose again, so with Him God will also bring those who have fallen asleep (died) in Jesus... .... and those who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord shall in no way precede those who are asleep. For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the blast of God's shofar, and the dead in Messiah shall rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left behind, will be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air..." - 1<sup>st</sup> Thessalonians 4:13-17***

What we just read above conflict with the Old Testament books, because nowhere in the Old Testament books mentioned about that at all. Which is why I, Bro. Pouliot seeing how this conflicts with what [Daniel 12:1-2](#) said; **both the righteous and unrighteous dead will raise at the same time**, and then there will be 2<sup>nd</sup> death for the unrighteous who will be judged to stay dead forever (Isaiah 26:19-21).

Another conflict about the coming messiah, we were told about Jesus Christ from the New Testament books who will return to Earth on the last day. Plus, we are being told about John the Baptist who will prepare the way "for the lord"; this conflict with Elijah who is the one who will appear before ~~YHWH~~ returns according to what the book of Malachi describes about this prophecy coming event. Elijah is the one who will announce the good news to everyone about the good news, that the new kingdom is coming. And he will mention for us to repent and turn back to HIM, ~~YHWH~~ our Creator Almighty ONE. Like a second chance to be right with HIM.

Most people don't realize the truth about the ancient temple in the city of Zion that was once damaged by this great earthquake during King Uzziah's day.

**"The words of Amos, who was among the shepherds from Tekoa. He perceived these words concerning Israel during *the days of Uzziah, king of Judah, and during the days of Jeroboam son of Joash, king of Israel, two years before the earthquake*". - Amos 1:1**

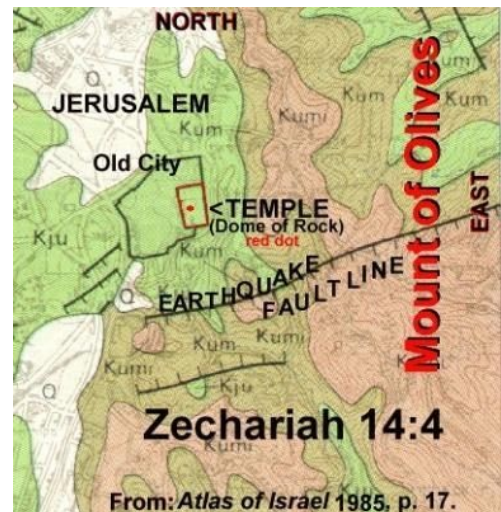

According to the day of Amos, he had a vision of an earthquake that would happen two years later. Zechariah also had this vision of this great quake. Both talk about how Mount Olive divided. Meaning.... this future prophecy had nothing to do with the second coming of Jesus Christ. Because these two passage verses had already been fulfilled. During the days of Uzziah, king

There is another false claim we were taught or told by what the New Testament book of Matthew 27:51-53 said. Stating about the day Jesus Christ who had died on the cross/stake, there was an earthquake and the dead who were RIP in their grave had risen. This cannot be true, because the last serious earthquake ever recorded in Israel had caused some damage; along with the temple were the days of Uzziah, king of Judah. There were NO other big quakes recorded later after Uzziah's day.



**"And behold, the curtain of the Temple was split in two, from top to bottom. And the earth quaked and rocks were split apart. And the tombs were opened, and many bodies of the kedoshim who were sleeping were raised to life. And coming forth out of the tombs after**

***His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many”***

And what is strange is, why does this “***curtain of the Temple was split***” sound almost like “***temple’s roof split***” from one of the early Jewish Writings ***Antiquities IX 10:4***? According to an article on Patterns of Evidence, Josephus wrote that the quake hit when Uzziah was in the Temple and that it split the roof causing sunbeams to hit on the king’s face at the moment leprosy seized upon him.

Ezekiel chapter 37 describes how the death of their bone will be raised alive in the flesh. Yes, in the flesh ***body again, not a spiritual body***. On that day of the resurrection, HIS people will not defile themselves again with their idols and with vile idols and with all of their transgressions (Ezekiel 37:23).

The whole point here is Jesus of the New Testament books does not speak of the truth. He is not coming back for us. It is ***אֱלֹהִים***, our true only Creator ONE, the only KING of kings and SAVIOR of the world who will return for us. Plus, the former King David will rise to live again and he will be a king again according to what Ezekiel said in chapter 37, verses 24-25:

***“...my servant David will be king over them, and one shepherd will be for all of them, and in my regulations they will go, and my statutes they will observe, and they will do them. And they will dwell on the land that I gave to my servant, to Jacob, in which your ancestors dwelled, and they will dwell on it, they and their children and the children of their children forever, and my servant David will be a leader for them forever.”***

Many people who read and study the scripture books somehow miss this chapter of Ezekiel. Not knowing that King David will sit on his throne. While ***אֱלֹהִים*** being our Creator ONE, the Almighty KING of all kings on earth.

Remember how ***אֱלֹהִים*** created everything in six days Genesis 1 &2, before HE created another day as a memorial Sabbatical day to remember where we come from and how we are to thank ***אֱלֹהִים*** for everything we need in our daily life. In a similar way to how Adam, the first human was created out of dust during the creation of heavens and earth, HE can recreate our body the same way back live and time forever.
