


Moed of Pesach


Appointed Time of Passover



Ancient ago אֱלֹהִים lead HIS people out of Kemet (Mitzrayim or Egypt), because in Genesis 15:13, אֱלֹהִים told Ab-Raham (Abraham), **“Know for certain that your offspring will be sojourners in a land that is not theirs and will be servants there, and they will be afflicted for four hundred years.”** אֱלֹהִים knows everything that will happen, and HE revealed part of the future to Abraham. אֱלֹהִים’s plan included sending the Yisraelites (Israelites) to Kemet for 400 years. The reason so long, אֱלֹהִים’s plan for the Promised Land to Yisraelites because **“the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete”** - verse 16. The Amorites people were worshipping their gods and participated in numerous of other sins. אֱלֹהִים promised to remove them from the land where the true Yisraelites will one day live there. However, אֱלֹהִים had it plan in certain period of time that included 400 years for Israelite’s salve in Kemet. Once

the Yisraelites did return to the land promised to them, the Amorites were destroyed as the Almighty Sovereign ONE predicted (Numbers 21:31-32; Joshua 10:10; 11:8).

By the time Israelite was set to be free from the Kemet slavery, אֱלֹהִים choice Moshe (Moses) and his brother Aharon (Aaron) to lead HIS people out of Kemet. After the stubborn Pharaoh refused to let the Yisraelites go free. אֱלֹהִים brought 10 plagues upon the Kemetians kingdom until Pharaoh finally gave up and let Israelite go. The last plagues were to deliver firstborn death on the land of Kemet. **FYI: livestock of firstborn in Kemet were also put to death.** אֱלֹהִים gave Moshe the instruction to the Yisraelites what to do on the tenth day of the first month (March/April). That the Yisraelites were to start getting ready to follow certain steps. At dusk (sunset) they were to slaughter a male sheep (or goat) and splash some of its blood on their doorposts and lintel of their house (Ex. 12:3-7, 22, 23). They were also told to have a meal of roasted lamb along with unleavened bread and some herbs. After that, angel of death PASS-OVER the land and all the first born on the land of Kemet died, but the obedient Yisraelites would be protected by אֱלֹהִים.





That day is known as “Pesach” in Hebrew translated word. This is why that day became a memorial Pesach, a day to honor and give thanks to אֱלֹהִים for all the mighty and marvel things HE did on that day and why. אֱלֹהִים also want HIS people not to forget and understand why HE is so important to them. He wants HIS creation children to know where they came from and why is HE keeping the Covenant promise between HIM and these people as well. Because אֱלֹהִים made this Covenant promise with Ab-Raham (Abraham), Yashkaq (Isaac), Ya’aqub (Jacob) and all of their future descendants who will get this promise land from the river of Kemet (Egypt) to the land of Euphrates. The future promised land, the Land of Israel will forever be there. These Covenant promise also except HIS children of Yisraelites to fully respect, follow, practice and guard all of אֱלֹהִים’s laws. Otherwise, they will lose that Covenant promise.

This appointed time Passover/Unleavened Bread is the first-fruits annual feast festival holiday of the year. There are seven festival appointed times holiday but, there are three first-fruits harvest feast festival annual holidays:

- 1st New Moon (New Year)
- Passover Unleavened Bread – Yom Habikkurim
- Feast of Weeks (2nd First-Fruits festival) – Shavuot
- Day of Trumpets – Yom Teruah (Rosh Hashanah)
- Day of Atonement – Yom Kippur
- Feast of Tabernacles – Sukkot

In the book of Leviticus chapter 23 teach us all of this seven festival appointed time holidays. אֱלֹהִים told Moshe, **“Speak to the Yisraelites and say to them: ‘These are my appointed festivals, the appointed festivals of the Almighty ONE, which you are to proclaim as sacred assemblies’** (also mentioned in Exodus 12:14). All these festival holidays are indeed to be observed forever all generation.

“Three times in the year you shall keep a feast to me. You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread. As I commanded you, you shall eat unleavened bread for seven days at the appointed time in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt. None shall appear before me empty-handed. You shall keep the Feast of Harvest, of the first fruits of your labor, of what you sow in the field. You shall keep the Feast of Ingathering at the end of the year, when you gather in from the field the fruit of your labor. Three times in the year shall all your males appear before the Almighty.” - Exodus 23:14-17 (NKJV)

Now that you as the reader of this document article, see why this Passover/ Unleavened Bread appoint importation memorial day remembering. We are not to change this understanding memorial day Passover. Just as we do not change our memorial date birthday. For example, people who practice and believe what the New Testament doctrine teach about Jesus (or YahuSha). Stating that Jesus is the foreshadow sacrifice Passover lamb of the Old Testament books. They who totally believe in this New Testament doctrine preaching people that this Passover sacrifice was all about the coming salvation Jesus, the Messiah. He who died on the cross (or tree) as sacrifice lamb, to pay off the penalty for people sins and reconciling people to mercifully forgive. This I say WATCH-OUT, this is a foolish trick like how Satan had trick Adam's wife about the forbidden fruit in the first place. Passover memorial is NOT all about Jesus in the first place. Since it all about what our heavenly Father **יהוה** did in Kemet (Egypt).



The next thing I have learned is, how did I determine to find out the exact day of **יהוה**'s Passover & Unleavened Bread Day along with our modern-day Roman-Gregorian pagan time system? Since Roman-Gregorian calendar system is completely different from how to track **יהוה**'s time system. According to Leviticus 23:5-8 studied, **יהוה**'s Passover day service begins at sundown (dusk) evening on the fourteenth day of the first month.

"During the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month in the evening, is Adonai's Passover. On the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Matzot to Adonai. For seven days you are to eat matzah. On the first day you are to have a holy convocation and you should do no regular work. Instead you are to present an offering made by fire to Adonai for seven days. On the seventh day is a holy convocation, when you are to do no regular work."

As you can see here to read few of the scripture passage, that the first month in these passage verses of Leviticus 23:5-8 dose not mean the month of January, which is winter season. Because according to Exodus 12:2; 23:15 & Deuteronomy 16:1, it mentioned about the month of Abib (or Aviv). That is because the word Abib (or Aviv)" is a Hebrew translated word for "green ears of grain" or "young ears of barley". This we can see why it is a spring season other than winter January month and spring season is the beginning of the new moon (month) yearly cycle.



The developmental of young green ear barley stages: (A) At around Awn Tipping most barley plants pass through anthesis, while the spike is still enclosed in the flag leaf sheath. This is the actual “flowering time” stage of spring barley because fertilization happens now. (B) Spike heading half of spike emerged). (c) is the best judgment young green ear barley stage check. (d) anther extrusion occurs later and usually do not coincide with the fertilization events.

“This month will mark the beginning of months for you; it is to be the first month of the year for you.”

OR

*“This month is the head of months for you; it is the first month of the year to you.”
(NIPS)*

“Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: (thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt...”

“Observe the month of Abib, and keep the Passover unto the Almighty thy Sovereign ONE: for in the month of Abib the Almighty thy Sovereign ONE brought thee forth out of Egypt by night.”



This is how I have come to understand, the first day of the first month during the time Yisraelites was leaving Egypt. It all happens during the beginning spring season. The other thing I learned about is the “New Moon” also mean new month. Here number of example where scripture passage mentioned about the “New Moon”.

“...and whenever burnt offerings were offered to אֱלֹהִים on Shabbatot, New Moons and the feast of festivals. They were to serve regularly before אֱלֹהִים, the Sovereign ONE, according to the proper number in the manner prescribed for them.” – 1st Chronicles 23:31

“Sound the ram’s horn at the New Moon, and when the moon is full, on the day of our festival;” – Psalm 81:3

“He made the moon for appointed times; the sun knows its going down.” – Psalm 104:19



As we can see in these passage verses, it tells us that sun, stars, and MOON give us sign in the sky, to guide us the time of seasons. This explains why Genesis 1:14-16 said,

“Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night. And let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days and years, and let them be lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light upon the earth.” And it

was so. And אֱלֹהִים made the two great lights—the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night—and the stars.”

Start of Day or Night?

So, now we know when the season of month begin but do, but do most people fully understand when the day begin? I have already mentioned that I believe the 24-hours day begin at dawn instead what other believers say sundown dusk is the actual starting 24-hour day. Let read what was אֱלֹהִים's first creation word in Genesis:



“Then the Creator ONE said, Let there be light. And there was light. And the Creator ONE saw the light that it was good, and Creator ONE separated the light from the darkness.”

Notice in this verses 3 and 4 of Genesis chapter one, אֱלֹהִים's first spoken word was “LIGHT” which appear in the void of darkness. This “LIGHT” is not the sun but אֱלֹהִים, himself who brightness the light in the darkness.

“The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.” - Psalm 119:130

“Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.” - Psalm 119:105

“אֱלֹהִים is my light and my salvation, whom shall I fear? אֱלֹהִים is the strength of my life, of whom shall I be afraid?” - Psalm 27:1

“Surely thou art my light, O אֱלֹהִים : who the Creator ONE will lighten my darkness.” - 2 Samuel 22:29

All these passage verses give us enough understanding why אֱלֹהִים is the true light of the world. He is the ONE who the I AM who begins the life to appear (or arise) that day he created the first light. So, after he lightness himself the first true light other than the sun, moon and stars, the larger lights HE created is the “SUN” to rule the day, and the lesser light “MOON” HE created to rule the night according to Genesis 1:16. This is why the “SUN” rule the “DAY” while the “MOON” rule the night and because DAY rule over the NIGHT. Since אֱלֹהִים created a light, he began the living to rise. Just as Isaiah 60:1 said “Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the אֱלֹהִים has risen upon you. Daylight hour is an arising time of the day to labor, while the night is a dead sleeping time. This is why we sleep over night, and this is because light is better than darkness (Ecclesiastes 2:13).

"Light dawns in the darkness for the upright; he is gracious, merciful, and righteous." - Psalm 112:4

- The lesson I have learned, we are not to get confused with the setting of the New Moon sundown evening for the beginning of the 24-hours day. At sundown evening beginning of the new day because of what other teachers or Pastors say. NO NO...
- Or about the Yom Kippur—the "Day of Atonement"— from evening to evening because of what other teachers or Pastors say. NO NO...
- Or the established pattern during the creation in Genesis, from evening to morning is day one (Genesis 1:2-3) because of what other teachers or Pastors say. NO NO...
- Or how the gates were being shut before evening sundown (dusk) to prevent the Sabbath from having people defiled via the merchants' buying and selling because of what other teachers or Pastors say. NO NO...

All these ideal doctrine people have been teaching children after children are still total mix-up with twilight doctrine. Let me explain why that is.

The reason the Passover instruction was at sundown evening was because of how the New Moon setting happens at sundown horizon. It is a servicing time to perform the Passover sacrifice at that hour. This isn't the beginning of the 24 hours day, since the New Moon is not the sun that rules the 24 hours "DAY" anyway. Most of all... why were the Israelites instructed to eat all the Passover meat before the morning hour? This is because morning is another day.

The Day of Atonement at the other hand, has nothing to do with the New Moon setting at sundown evening (DUSK). If we read the passage scripture very carefully in Leviticus 23:27-32, hopefully the reader will notice. Notice how the 9th day mentioned about the "EVENING" while the 10th day of the 7th month did not....why is that? It is because the 9th day already took care of the first evening timing of the hour to the next day (10th) last evening hour. From 9th day (which is not the Day of Atonement) evening to the next day (10th) evening is the Day of Atonement. Once again.... Why is that? It is because ^{אֲנִי} want us to afflict our souls: to fast before the next day, which is the Day of Atonement. No food is to be eaten before sundown (dusk) of the 9th day, in order to have our stomach empty for the following next day. Until the end of evening of the 10th day, we then are allowed to eat. Similar like a surgeon will instruct us to avoid food and water for up to 12 hours before surgery. Fasting before surgery helps prevent complications.

Let's go back to Genesis chapter one, verse five where it said, *"There came to be evening and there came to be morning, the first day"*. In this passage verse, we must read it carefully and understand how this ancient understanding set of mind explained to us. We can NOT automatically take as a conclusion that the "EVENING" is, therefore, the beginning of the day, just because it mentioned first in the scripture. Here what it should have been clearly understood.

From the end of the evening hours to the hour before the dawn/sunrise morning hours, this is the last 12 hours of the night. Because the first 12 hours daylight was during the time אָרְבַּח was creating the world from the morning hour to the end of the evening hour. Then there was evening end and there was coming morning. That what make 12 plus 12 = 24 hours. Just like we work during the daylight hour, but the night hour we do nothing but sleeping in bed.

The next part to talk about is the gates. The gates of Jerusalem had to shut before evening (it was getting dark). Because ancient Yisraelites know the best timing way to get ready for the next following day. That next following day was the Sabbatical appointed time, whether it the 7th day Sabbath, Passover, Day of Trumpets, or Festival of Tabernacles. People during that hour before it was getting dark, were completely their business work for the day. They also wanted to get everything set and ready for the following next day. So that they can rest and sleep for the rest of the night. This way, they won't have to worry about the rest of the night. This is why the gate were kept shut also during the sabbatical hour of the day. To prevent from any kind of people to enter, so they won't be able to merchants' business buying and selling people in Jerusalem (Nehemiah 13:19).

This is how people misunderstood this part, when they think the end of evening sundown dusk is the beginning of Shabbat rest. Because they thought the beginning of rest start at night before they go to sleep. Generation after generation, people have been falling to believe what the teachers/Pastors have said or taught them about sundown evening because of what they claimed what the scripture said, did not study and read carefully enough. They did not have a proper wisdom mind and educated.


The Correct Tracking Understanding Instruction

Now that we know how to track the 24-hour day, month and year based on אָרְבַּח's instruction signs of time of the sun, moon, and stars. We now need to get back about the early young ripeness green ears barley. We are to check for this early barley in the field before the next setting new moon to happen. This way we know exactly when the first month of the year start. This is why the first month of the year is also called the month of Aviv or Abib. Because Aviv is a Hebrew translated word, it means "green ears of grain" or "young ears of barley".

Once we get to know that the first day of the new moon-first month, we must count 14th day from day one. That how we know when the Passover day land on that day. Even we will also see the full moon on that Passover/Unleavened Bread day as well. The fifteenth day on the same month is also אָרְבַּח's Festival of Unleavened Bread day. We must not eat leavened bread but eat the unleavened bread for seven days.

Now the question here we should ourselves, why are we instructed not to eat leavened bread but unleavened bread? According to Exodus 12:17, the reason is, is to remember that אָרְבַּח brought Yisraelites out of the land of Egypt and also because Israelites had to leave Egypt in such a hurry that they did not have a spare time to rise their breads. Now, we can see why both, the Passover purpose, and the unleavened bread purpose as well. This is the reasons why it is another memorial appointed day of אָרְבַּח. The first memorial holiday is the 7th Day Shabbat, the second/third is the Passover/Unleavened Bread days, the fourth is Feast of Weeks, and the rest of the festival appointed holiday you already know what it is.


Determine in Your Time-Zone Location



The next thing I have come to realized, what Deuteronomy 16:5 said:

“You must not sacrifice the Passover in any town עָרֶיךָ gives you, except in the place he will choose as a dwelling for his Name.”

Because of what this scripture passage said, עָרֶיךָ did finally have Yisraelites settle down in Jerusalem and command them to build the temple their long time ago. Where all people once come to worship and sacrifice animal there. Right now, the temple of עָרֶיךָ name once stood in Jerusalem, isn't there anymore. It was destroyed back in 70 CE. This is the reason why we today we no longer require doing the sacrifice animal's blood because we don't have the temple to do the sacrifice service.



However, this does not mean we no longer require worship to honor and give thanks to עָרֶיךָ on any appointed time holidays festival. Meaning, we can still do the worshipping anywhere wherever we are in the world. But we still must follow up checking for the barley green ear (Aviv) season in Jerusalem or the same distance of the earth's equator to Jerusalem. For example, the distance from Jerusalem to the earth's equator is about

2,196.87 mi (3,535.52 km). We can still check for the green barley ear plants wherever we are in the country we live in, in the same 2,196.87 miles distance from the earth's equator. Because the season climate and weather would considered be like how it is in Jerusalem. This applies to the Northern Hemisphere season. If anyone of you live in the Southern Hemisphere side of the world, you must follow the Northern Hemisphere spring season way, while your season is fall.

Every time you celebrate the Passover/Unleavened Bread festival holiday in the Southern Hemisphere, it will always be fall season for you. But you must keep in mind as spring for Passover/Unleavened Bread memorial time for פסח .

Why is the Passover NOT the Sin Offering?

The mark on the doorpost which the Yisraelites did, was never about the sacrifice of the lamb for the forgiveness of sin. Did you notice in Exodus 12:5, the blood on the doorpost was not just the lamb's blood but also the goats' blood. The blood on the doorpost was all about the sign of peace offering as well. פסח protected HIS people from the spirit of death, which it PASSEVER their doors.



“For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night and strike down every firstborn, both men and animals, and I will execute judgments against all the gods of Egypt.” - Exodus 12:12



The last plagues were delivered by death on the land of Egypt's firstborn. All the firstborn people and livestock all died that day. The Pharaoh finally gave-up because his firstborn died, and he lets the Yisraelites go free.

This is what the Passover was all about. This is why פסח made this day a memorial holiday Passover/ Unleavened Bread days. Please do not get confused and fall along with the so-called Jesus Christ, the Passover Lamb. That Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!” (John 1:29). That he died for our sin offering for atonement. That kind of New Testament is teaching is all false. Because the Old

Testament Passover was all about the Peace Offering, NOT A SIN OFFERING. Most people do not realize, the sin offering was to use the BULL instead of lamb.

“And this is the thing that thou shalt do unto them to hallow them, to minister unto me in the priest's office: Take one young bullock, and two rams without blemish...

*...And thou shalt cause a bullock to be brought before the tabernacle of the congregation: and Aaron and his sons shall put their hands upon the head of the bullock. And thou shalt kill the bullock before Master **אֱלֹהִים**, by the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And thou shalt take of the blood of the bullock, and put it upon the horns of the altar with thy finger, and pour all the blood beside the bottom of the altar..."*

...And thou shalt offer every day a bullock for a sin offering for atonement: and thou shalt cleanse the altar, when thou hast made an atonement for it, and thou shalt anoint it, to sanctify it." -Exodus 29:1; 10-16; 36

As you can see, mostly BULL but also rams. No where is found to perform with a lamb for the sin offering for the people. The same for how Leviticus 4:1-6; 19-20; 27-29; 33 mentioned a BULL as well. The special Day of Atonement is the other appointed time holiday which is for the sin offering to cleaning and forgiving. This appointed Day of Atonement does not happen until the fall season. This is one of the many reason why I no longer follow Jesus, the false coming Messiah that come from the New Testament doctrine. I only follow and believe in the Almighty Sovereign ONE who name is **אֱלֹהִים**. He who made the heaven and earth is the ONLY SAVIOR, the Most-High, the King of all kings etc...

Now we should be able to fully understand why the Passover/Unleavened Bread was first made this day as memorial appointed time holiday during the time what **אֱלֹהִים** did for HIS people (Yisraelites) back in the ancient day in Kemet (Egypt). It was NEVER about another story of Jesus as the Lamb of God which is the shadow of what is to come because the New Testament books said so. Most of all, all of the Old Testament memorial feast festival appointed time holiday, **אֱלֹהִים** commanded HIS people to keep all these appointed festivities holidays as lasting ordinance for generation to generation. And also, **אֱלֹהִים** do not change what HE had made first in the convent. The same reason why Deuteronomy 4:44-28:68 teaches us about the Commandments.

I will not violate my covenant or alter what my lips have uttered - Psalm 89:34
