TURKEY or THANK?



Wondering what the ideal topic is about, you're about to discover this as shocking truth behind the false Thanksgiving Day holiday. The real truth that had been hidden from us; by our own past leaders. I was born and raised in the commonwealth state of Massachusetts. And I know well about this famous historical story about the Pilgrims who arrived in Plymouth Massachusetts back in 1620. This in fact was the historical truth but was not part of the original Thanksgiving Day memorial. You are about to find out why.

The traditional holiday Thanksgiving-Day we know of today marks on the fourth Thursday of every November month of the year. I was taught that this Day of Thanksgiving holiday traditionally is a day to set aside; a time family and friends gather. A time to remember this special festival day. As to where we came from and how the Native Americans became our friendly neighbor who had helped Pilgrims survive the first year. I was also told that both ate a huge feeding meal such as vegetable, pumpkin pie, and turkey together. Eating at long tables back in the 17th century. By the time I was in my late 30s, I'd discovered the shocking truth behind this traditional Thanksgiving Day. After investigating the other false holidays like Christmas and Easter. I wanted to find out if the Americans' Thanksgiving Day holiday was also false or not. It turned out that this turkey-Thanksgiving holiday is false. Found out that this Americans' Thanksgiving Day was originally first about the victory over the Pilgrims War back in 1636–37. Murdering all the Native American. Taken over their land as their new homeland.

I remember how my father along with my brother and sister used to go to my grandparent's place for the holiday turkey dinner. I remember watching the marching parade on the living-room television. The marching parade was filled with dressing turkeys, Pilgrims, and somehow did remember seeing dressing as Native Americans Indians and/or other colonial or media characters figures. After the parade, we watched the football games. I also remember how the grownups would play poker games in the evening after dinner. I also remember how we went out to the movie theater as well. We sometimes pray to thank God for the meal, family gathering and everything else before we start eating the turkey meals. All this I have witnessed myself and experienced all these celebrations I thought were true and good in the eyes of our Creator ONE. Until 2006, everything changed about what I believed since then.

HISTORIAL FACTS:

We were told to have teachers to pass on this historical Thanksgiving turkey day history in school, while we were a child. Telling us a story of how the pilgrims sailed on a Mayflower ship and got lost in sea during a bad storm. Traveling from Europe and arriving in America, but they were supposed to arrive in Virginia instead of Massachusetts. When the Mayflower arrived, there were 103 pilgrims. Only 56 survived during the first long winter season. There was one survivor in that colony who was the Patuxet Indian, a man named Squanto who survived from the slavery of England. He was kidnapped from America. Squanto knew their

language because he had spent time in England learning their language before coming back to America to his homeland. He was the one who somehow, along with some other native American who were not part of the colony, guided the pilgrims to survive the first winter year. Squanto may have taught the colony how to grow corn and catch fish etc... Even the pilgrims may have used Squanto to negotiate a peace treaty between the Native American. Yet, during that time there was some trouble going on between the members of the colony who did not trust Squanto as well as Squanto didn't trust some of them who had no compassion. Which is why there were numerous deaths going on during that first winter year.

We were told that William Bradford who was a governor during the mid-1600s proclaimed to establish the day of Thanksgiving-Day. As how he established this day to honor Heavenly Father and prepared a great feast honoring and thanking the neighboring Native American for helping them survive the first year. While the survivors (pilgrims) also claimed that they had made new friendships with these mystery tribes and traded valuable things with them throughout the first year. After reaping their first harvest in the fall of 1621, they also claimed that they did dedicate a day to thank the Creator Father who made heaven and earth. For the bounty which they believe HE had blessed them with reason they are here in America.

Part of that blessing cannot be true, because there were a number of historical facts that British settlers had seized their land, capturing strong young Natives for slaves, and killing the rest. Which is why the Pequot tribal native never wants to agree with the white man's lie about the peace treaty. Squanto was involved in this peace treaty negotiated that day before the Pequot War in 1636-7. This war happened in our present-day location near Groton, Connecticut. Over 700 men, women and children of the Pequot tribe had gathered for their annual Green Corn Festival (FYI: not the Thanksgiving Day) celebration day. In the predawn hours, they were sleeping surrounded by English and Dutch mercenaries who ordered them to come outside. Those who came out were shot or clubbed to death while the terrified women and children who huddled inside the longhouse were burned alive.

The next day, the governor of the Massachusetts Bay Colony declared "A Day Of *Thanksgiving*", to cheer their victory when their brave white men (and some of their Indian allies who were traitors) attacked village after village. Women and children over 14 were sold into slavery while the rest were murdered. Ships loaded with as many as 500 slaves regularly left the ports of New England. Bounties were paid for Indian scalps to encourage as many deaths as possible. Following an especially successful raid against the Pequot in what is now Stamford, Connecticut, the churches announced a second day of "thanksgiving" to celebrate victory over the heathen savages. There are many more stories along with this dark hidden truth.

October 3rd, 1789, George Washington, the first president of U.S. America had made the following proclamation and created the first Thanksgiving Day holiday designated by the national government. Also during the middle of the American' Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln, prompted by a series of editorials written by Sarah Josepha Hale, proclaimed a national Thanksgiving Day, which is how we get this celebrated day on the final Thursday of every November month since 1863.

All of this is very disrespectful and it's still their rightful land for many generations long before the European invasion. That also goes for Columbus Day as well, because people claimed Christopher Columbus had discovered America first. To ignore the Native America and allow Europeans to claim the land. He ONLY discovered the island of Hispaniola in 1492, which is present-day Haiti/Dominican Republic, Juana which is present-day called Cuba, San Juan Bautista which is present-day Puerto Rico and Santiago which is present-day Jamaica. I do remember watching the television program as Native American seem to always battle against the white men. Because they dislike them taking over their land. Mostly on the western television shows with cowboys etc... This is why I began to have a suspicion during the early years long before I finally investigated the history. After all of those discoveries of the paganism Turkey Thanksgiving Day, I found out there is a true THANKSGIVING DAY. - Festival of Harvest Chag HaKatzir
- Day of Trumpets Yom Teruah (Rosh Hashanah)
- Day of Atonement Yom Kippur
- Last Festival of Ingathering Chag HaAsif

All of those appointed days holiday are the only appointed holiday which YAH only accepts because HE is the ONE who commanded us to remember those day. All of those days are the REAL THANKSGIVING HONORING DAYS. To thank YAH for salvation and everything along with HIS LOVE. While the American' Thanksgiving celebration holiday is not what YAH want us to follow and practice at all.
