


tHe NaME of ReLiGIoN?

Long before my view of beliefs about the Bible teaching has changed several times, James 1:26-27 was my favorite memory scripture passage. But not anymore, for few reasons. The first main reason is, it's because I no longer believe in the New Testament Bible. The book of James is in the New Testament books. Later in this document article, I, Bro. Pouliot will brief explains why I no longer believe in the New Testament Bible. The other reason, I have learned a great deal about this word 'RELIGLON'. That this word 'RELIGLON' did not exist later after 1200's AD. Century after century, the defining word for 'RELIGLON' had change over time and it had caused a lot of confusion.



According to online **Wikipedia**, the free encyclopedia said 'RELIGLON' is a set of variously organized beliefs about the relationship between natural and supernatural aspects of reality, and the role of humans in this relationship. The **American Heritage Dictionary** said it a personal or institutionalized system grounded in such belief and worship. The **Oxford Dictionaries** said, belief in and worship of a superhuman controlling power, especially a personal God or gods. The problem with all these different defines dictionary word, the Bible teaches us that there is ONLY ONE beliefs which lead to ONE Creator Almighty (GOD). Why does the book of James chapter one, verses 26 and 27 used this word 'RELIGLON' or 'RELIGIOUS', which it means a variously set of different beliefs?

In the early day before I've decided why the New Testament Bible is a false doctrine books, I knew there is a problem with the word 'RELIGION' in James 1:26-27. I figure during that time that the word 'RELIGION' was somehow replace. After number of research, I did discover an error about this word 'RELIGION', here why. I noticed a Bible version called *Besorah of YahUah in THE MESSIANIC WRITINGS*:

If anyone among you thinks he is observant and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's observance is worthless. Clean and undefiled observance before the Elohim and Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction and to keep oneself unstained from the world.

I asked myself why did not this version used the word 'RELIGION'? Better yet, the word 'OBSERVANT' in that passage verse make a perfect sense then using the word 'RELIGION'. Because 'OBSERVANT' is described as person who practices and guard YAH's teaching LAWS (Torah). A follower who is a believer who observe the laws.

And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the YAH our Creator ONE, as he hath commanded us. - Deuteronomy 6:25

Gather the people together, men, and women, and children, and thy stranger that [is] within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the YAH your Creator ONE, and observe to do all the words of this law: - Deuteronomy 31:12

That they might observe his statutes, and guard his laws. Praise ye the YAH. - Psalms 105:45

I gave them My statutes and informed them of My ordinances, by which, if a man observes them, he will live. - Ezekiel 20:11

Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall observe and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. - Matthew 5:19

Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, [even] unto the end of the world. Amen. - Matthew 28:20

He that observeth the day, observeth it to the Lord: and he that observeth not the day, observeth it not to the Lord. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord: for he giveth YAH thanks: and he that eateth not, eateth not to the YAH, and giveth YAH thanks. - Romans 14:6

Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, or he that condemneth his brother, speaketh evil of the Law, and condemneth the Law: and if thou condemnest the Law, thou art not an observer of the Law, but a judge. - James 4:11

Now you can see why James 1:26-27 point out the person who consider themselves as observant must be someone who do the good duties and love thy neighbor, by caring one another and help one another in a good moral way of life. To ensure one another to stay pure and faultless from the polluted of this worldly of man, who walk by YAH's way of life. YAH wants us to observe HIS commandments' laws. Notice in James 4:11 described those who do such evil doing against brother or practice evil law are no 'OBSERVER' of YAH's law. My question here, would it be possible that the word observer fixes in James 1:26-27, to care properly to other?

'Those who consider themselves religious (observer) and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion (observer) is worthless. The religion (observer)

that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world'

Now we know why the Bible like King James Version bible only have three passage for religion. Since many passage verses speak of observer of YAH law. Since religion is not just one belief but variety of beliefs, just don't make sense at all. Since the early 16th century Coverdale Bible, before KJV Bible came into exist... this bad influencing word religion somehow was not supposed to be in the Bible.

Here is another interesting thing about what the Jubilee Bible in Acts 26:5 did say, differ from other Bible version:

"Since they have known me from the first, if they wish to witness, that I lived as a Pharisee according to the strictest sect of our observance".

Here another Bible version called Tree of Life Version (TLV) in Romans 3:20 & 28:

"For no human, on the basis of Torah observance, will be set right in His sight—for through the Torah comes awareness of sin."

"For we consider a person to be set right apart from Torah observance."

It is indeed much clear that the passage verse for James 1:26-27 like what the Besorah of Yahuah in THE MESSIANIC WRITINGS (Bible) said is the correct fixing 'observant' word. While the word 'religion' is a pagan confusing trick word which Satan somehow trick us in this world for a long time. This is one of the reason why we should not use the word RELIGION when we ask people this question "WHAT RELIGION DO YOU BELIEVE IN OR PRATICE" or "WHAT RELIGION CHURCH DO YOU GO TO" instead we either say "WHAT BELIEF DO YOU BELIEVE IN" or "WHAT OBSERVANCE BELIEF DO YOU BELIEVE IN"? That is the clear correct way to say that, since the word 'RELIGION' somehow was not supposed to exist in the first place.

After I have discovered the truth about the false doctrine of Jesus/YahuSha, the so-called Messiah from the New Testament bible, I've discovered more about this dangerous word 'RELIGION'. MORE INFO ABOUT 'RELIGION'

After I have discovered the lied about the New Testament Bible, I can now see why we have so many different beliefs around the world today. The word 'religion' came from a word religare, and before religare, it came from 're' and 'lecture'. Back in the anicent re+legere was understood as 'read again'.

"Religare" is considered a stem for the word religion and has the meaning of binding, "to tie something with something", the human and the divine, "to connect" in some way; "re" is the preposition we all know, so that adds the nuance of reiteration and, in this particular case, intensity to the verb "ligare", which comes to mean the above.
